Key Principles

1. Curling members at High Park Club (HPC) are able to spare in sections in which they are not members.
2. For the purposes of this policy, the following definitions apply:
 - a. House Member - A member who has not paid Section Fees for any curling section
 - b. Curling Member - A curling member who has paid Section Fees for one or more curling sections
3. Members may join a Curling Section for a pro rata fee at any time prior to March 31st of each curling season.

Sparing - House Members

4. House Members who are in good standing are permitted to spare in any curling section for the regular season.
5. House Members may not spare during playoffs.

Sparing - Curling Members

6. Curling Members who are in good standing have unlimited sparing privileges for all curling sections.
7. Curling Members may spare in the playoffs of a Section in which they are not a member provided that Section's playoff rules allow such a spare.

Sparing - Youth Members

8. Youth Members who are only members of the Club's Youth Programs (i.e. Juniors, Little Rocks) have unlimited sparing privileges for all curling sections,

provided they meet the minimum age requirements for the section in which they are sparing and are accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Sparing - Non-Members

9. Non-members may not spare.
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Procedures - Infractions

10. Section Committees are not responsible for policing or enforcing any sparing rule, but are asked to bring any possible infractions to the attention of Club Management so it can be addressed.
